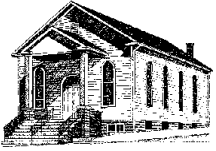

**Minutes Church Council Meeting
October 19, 2025**

Opening Prayer: Pastor Stapf

Items from the President:

- Joe stated that Vicar Chris Clarke has many competing responsibilities and will be taking some time off. Pastor Stapf and Joe will alternate preaching on Sunday's. Pastor Stapf will continue to provide Holy Communion on the 3rd Sunday of each month.

Review of September 2025 Council Minutes:

- Carrie stated that the last item under "Financial Matters" states that the Treasurer's report was approved for June. It should have been approved for July and August instead. Carrie will correct.
- Irv made a motion, seconded by Art, that the minutes of the September 21st meeting be approved after the correction. Motion granted.

Financial Matters:

- Bruce stated that our RBC balance for September is about \$188k.
- Bruce stated that our checking account has a balance of about \$24k.
- Art made a motion, seconded by Pastor Stapf, that the financials for September 2025 be approved as it. Motion granted.

- Jeane stated that Tom continues to work on issues with our website and should have it up and running in the next week.

New Business:

- Joe stated that we still need 1-2 more member(s) for Church Council.
- Joe stated that we need more members in our Church. Carrie stated that Rodney would like to join the Church. Pastor Stapf stated that he will meet with Rodney.
- Carrie stated that the cost of 50 boxes for Samaritan's Purse, Operation Christmas Child, is \$57. Carrie purchased 26 plastic containers with lids from the Dollar Tree to use. Bruce will reimburse her.
- Bruce stated that Griffith Energy came out to inspect and clean the furnace. The furnace will only be used if it gets too cold and the heat pump can't keep up.
