

In February we tend to especially remember Valentine’s Day, or more properly, St. Valentine’s Day. We usually associate the day with love and romance rather than with Jesus Christ and martyrdom. I’m not quite sure how we arrived at our current commemoration of the day with the love letters and chocolates. But St. Valentine himself was indeed a martyr for Jesus Christ who confessed the Lord until his last breath.

Not much is known for sure about St. Valentine. Most agree that he was a preacher of Jesus during the Roman persecution of Christians. He boldly confessed his faith even during a time when Christianity was punishable by death. One of the most popular stories about St. Valentine tells that he was arrested for preaching Jesus. His judge challenged him to heal his blind daughter. When St. Valentine’s prayers were answered and the girl was healed the judge and his whole household converted and was baptized. Later St. Valentine was again arrested for his evangelism and Emperor Claudius II sentenced him to death. St. Valentine went to his grave confessing his blessed Lord after trying to evangelize those who were killing him, even the pagan emperor himself.

It seems as if our nation and world are becoming more and more hostile to Jesus Christ like the Roman Empire of old. In our relative safety and comfort it is easy for us to forget that such persecution is a daily reality for many Christians around the world. Every day more and more are added to the ranks of the confessors and the martyrs. Even as St. Valentine himself once did, let us be faithful to minister to and pray for the persecuted. And let us be faithful to confess our Blessed Lord Jesus no matter the opposition. Our world offers many false paths and many lies which lead to death. But only Jesus is the true way, truth, and life, and those who endure in Him to the end will be saved.



Joy 4 Ukraine is about bringing the joy of the Gospel into the lives of orphans and children with special needs in Ukraine through compassion, care and community

My hope is every child and family we minister to will experience the joy that comes by knowing we are freely justified for Christ's sake through faith. Joy 4 Ukraine has a wide variety of seasonal and year round ministries, I would like to share a few of those which I feel have the most impact.

Ministries of Joy 4 Ukraine

Seasonal

Summer Bible camps for children with special needs.

Hosting Night to Shine, a special needs prom in February for around 100 youth.

Christmas visits to children with special needs, bringing gifts dressed as Father Frost (Ukrainian Santa).

Year round

Church of Hope-our weekly worship service that reaches out to people with special needs.

Weekly visits to the local orphanage for Boy's with special needs in Bila Tserkva, where we do Christian camp songs, Bible stories and crafts.

Weekly visits to the school for the deaf in Bila Tserkva.

Young Adult group gatherings on Friday evenings.

Handicap accessibility monitoring and advocating for people with disabilities with local community members.

I'm very excited for all the ministry opportunities we have to look forward to in 2021. Thank you so much for considering to support Joy 4 Ukraine.


