Epistle Article November 2021

²⁷ For I did not shrink from declaring to you the whole purpose of God. ²⁸ Be on guard for yourselves and for all the flock, among which the Holy Spirit has made you overseers, to shepherd the church of God which He purchased with His own blood. ²⁹ I know that after my departure savage wolves will come in among you, not sparing the flock; ³⁰ and from among your own selves men will arise, speaking perverse things, to draw away the disciples after them. ³¹ Therefore be on the alert, remembering that night and day for a period of three years I did not cease to admonish each one with tears. ³² And now I commend you to God and to the word of His grace, which is able to build you up and to give you the inheritance among all those who are sanctified. –Acts 20:27-32

The Apostle Paul delivered this message to the elders, or pastors, of Ephesus upon his departure. He did not hold back or spare them from the truth of what would happen after he left. Paul warned them that wolves would arise to endanger their flock. These false elders would teach perverse thing with the purpose of gaining followers and disciples for themselves rather than for Christ. Worst of all, these enemies would not come as strangers from the outside, but they would arise from within their own fold.

Although Paul's warning sounded pretty terrifying, and the elders of Ephesus surely needed to be on guard, they did not need to be afraid. Paul provided them with a defense. While Paul was with them he taught them the purity and truth of God's word. He said, "I did not shrink from declaring to you the whole purpose of God." Some translations say, "The whole counsel of God." Paul taught them everything they needed to stand firm on the truth of God's word and to guard themselves against the wolves who would arise.

Ultimately, those evil forces would not prevail against the Church. The Holy Spirit had appointed pastors, elders and overseers, to shepherd the Church, and Paul had instructed them well. But ultimately those shepherds were under a greater shepherd, a shepherd who shed His own blood for the Church, the Lord Jesus. He purchased and won the whole Church from sin, death, and all the powers of the devil by his shed blood on the cross. Though false teachers and opposing forces would surely arise to endanger the flock, God would defend them by the Holy Spirit and preserve them by His holy word. As we are faithful to hear God's word every week, even every day, we pray that God would also guard and sanctify us so that we, too, would be preserved by His word of grace.
